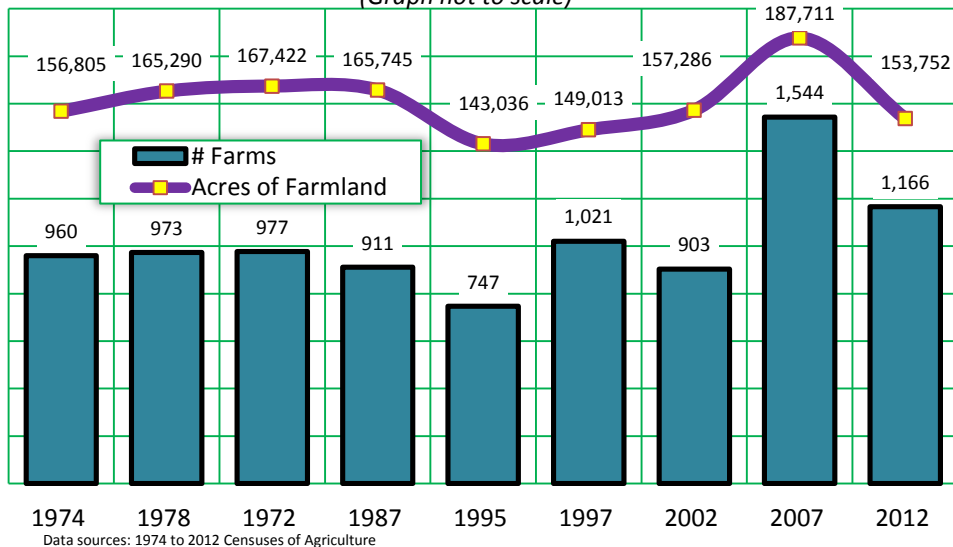


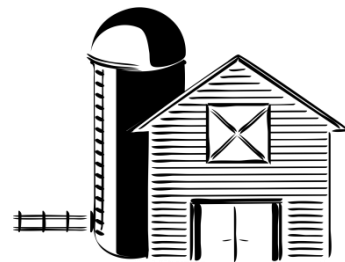
Farms and Acres of Farmland in Indiana County, 1974 to 2012

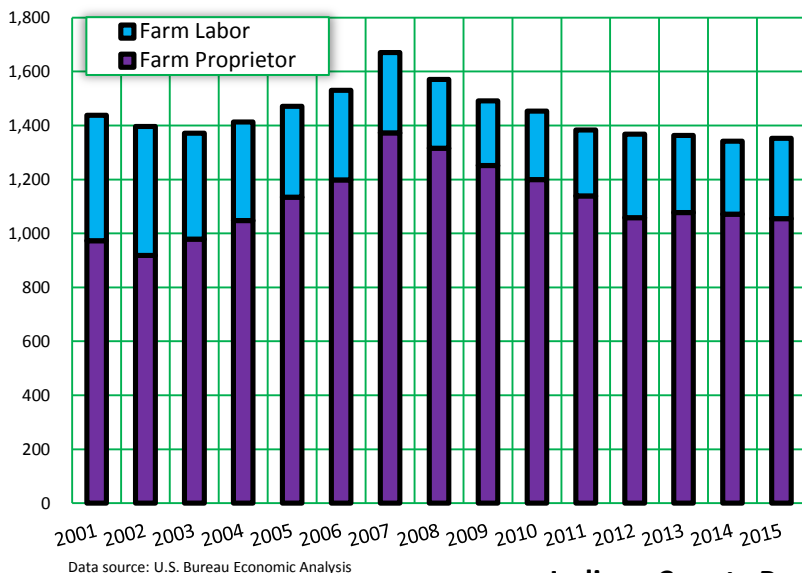

Farm Proprietors and Farm Labor in Indiana County, 2001 to 2015

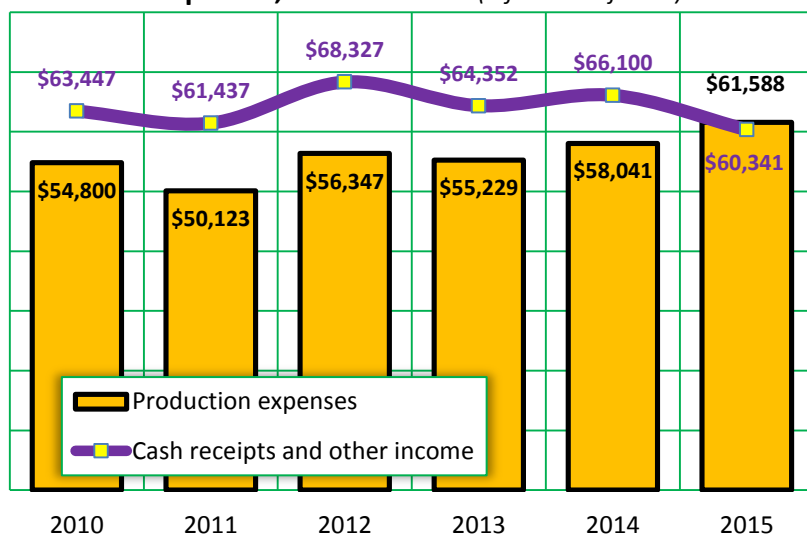


Top Five Commodity Groups by Sales in Indiana County, 2012

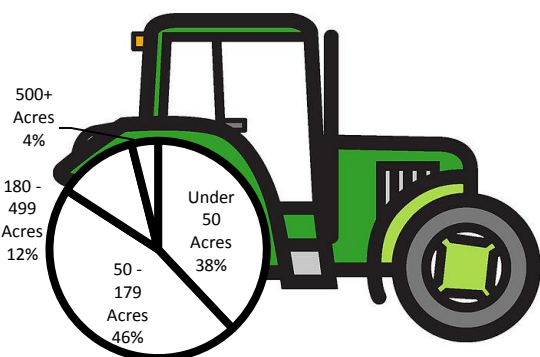
1. Grains, oilseeds, dry beans, and dry peas, \$21.34 million

Indiana County Production Expenses and Income per Farm Proprietor, 2010 to 2015 (Inflation adjusted)



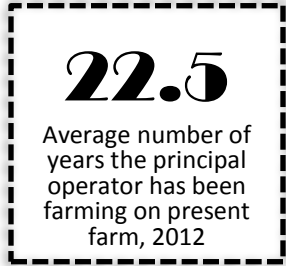
Indiana County Farms by Acres of Farmland, 2012



Number of Females Who are Principal Farm Operators in Indiana County, 2007 to 2012

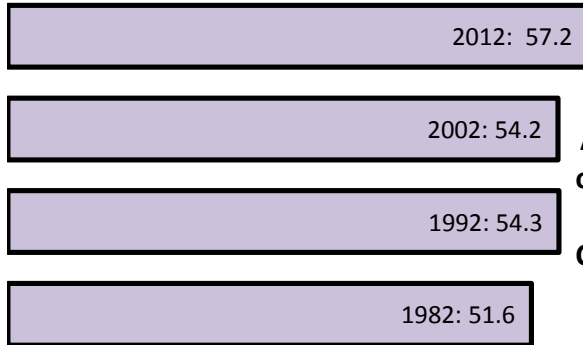

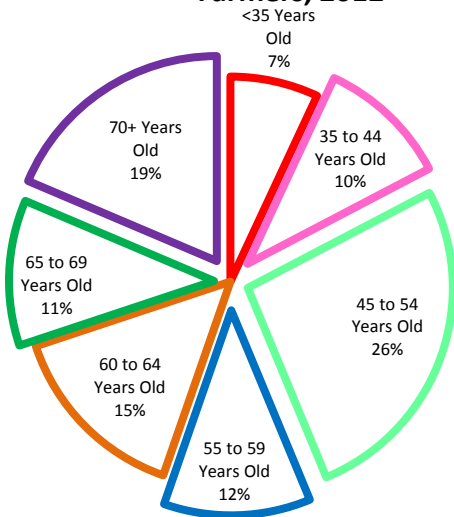

Average Age of Farmers in Indiana County, 1982 to 2012

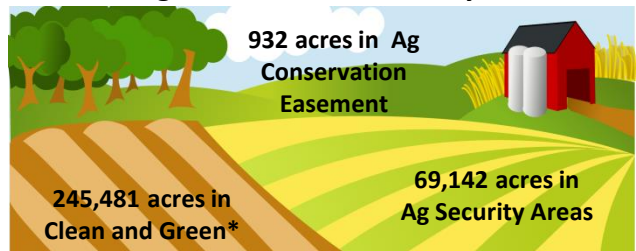

Age Range of Indiana County Farmers, 2012



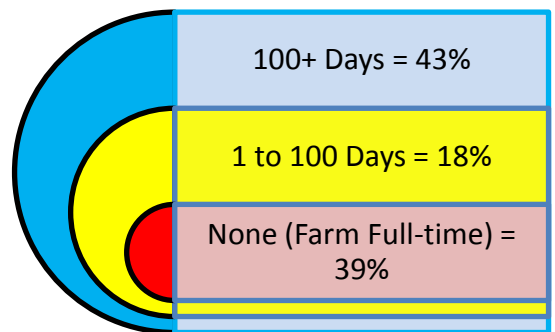

Percent of Farmers Working Off Farm in Indiana County, 2012



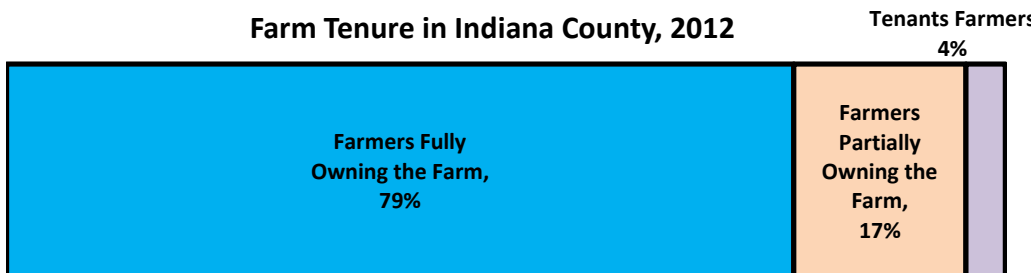
